

MAGA SKYMARATHON

Competition

Race is open to male and female athletes, over the age of 18, in possession of a valid Sports Medical Certificate. The race takes place on mountain paths but with demanding stretches both uphill and downhill and, in certain parts, fixed ropes, snow, exposed ledges, steep slopes and stony terrain – in other words, requiring good physical preparation and extreme caution.

Runners must have Fsa or Fidal card (This card can be also bought before the beginning of the race € 5.00)

The Race Committee, considering the nature of the competition, declines all responsibility or eventual accidents caused by participants' conduct not conforming to the rules or by third persons on the course for whatever reason.

Full collaboration is asked of all competitors to ensure a safe and successful outcome of the event and therefore to comply with all the rules.

The Race Committee declares to have public-liability insurance.

Meeting Point

Meeting point is at the "Palazzetto dello Sport" in Serina. From 5.00 a.m. till 6.00 a.m. is possible to collect racing bibs that shows your bib number

After received racing bibs, runners have to move to Zorzone (there is the possibility to book the transfer from Serina to Zorzone with the Race Committee)

Race Start is scheduled at 7.00 a.m.- September 7, 2014 at the square of Zorzone. The race start in Zorzone and finish in Serina.

Entry Fee

Entry Fee that includes: assistance and refreshment points along the course, showers, final greeting buffet, race gadget:

€ 30,00 - till 31.08.2014

€ 40,00 - from 01.09.2014 – to 05.09.2014

Entries can be made by online registration in the section of the web site [www. magaskymarathon.it](http://www.magaskymarathon.it) filling the Entry Form.

The entry is confirmed only after the receipt of the following documents: Sports Medical Certificate valid on the date of the race and payment receipt of the entry fee.

Registrations must be received within September 5, 18.00 p.m.

Please note that entry is not valid if any of mentioned document is missing.

Regulation

It's compulsory to follow the marked course – or risk disqualification.

The bib supplied by the organisers should be worn over any top or jacket and constantly visible throughout the race. Along the course there will be fixed check points and time limits.

At certain points along the course, medical assistance will be available. The medical team has the faculty of deciding if an athlete should retire and consign their bib.

Retirement is permitted only at one of the four refuges along the course where race marshals must be advised and the bib consigned. The bib will be charged for if not consigned.

It's compulsory to announcing and help an athlete in difficulty.

The Race Committee reserves the right to modify the programme and set up a reserve course with similar parameters. Depending on weather conditions the race may be anticipated by one day. In case of extreme weather conditions during the race, it may need to be suspended. In this case, the athletes must return according to instructions given at the check points. All responsibility is declined for athletes who do not observe these instructions or who decide to continue. The decision of the committee may not be contested and will be decided by a majority vote together with the race director. In the event of parity, the final decision will be with the Race Committee President.

In case of bad weather conditions, the race will take place following an alternative reserve track, which details will be found inside the event-pack. Prize money will be consequently halved.

Several points of first aid and assistance will be arranged along the track, to guarantee the

competitors safety. Registration relieves the Organization of civil and criminal liability for any damage that may occur to persons or property before, during or after the competition. Participants are not covered by any insurance.

The maximum time allowed to finish the race will be 8.30 hours for men. Time limits will be operative at "Capanna 2000" maximum time allowed 3.15 hours and at "Passo di Zambra": 6.00 hours.

At every snack points there are drinks and Energy drinks and foods. It's forbidden for participants to litter bottles or cups outside the aid station area.

Compulsory outfit: windproof jacket or vest and trail running shoes in good condition

A penalty of 3 minutes will be assigned for :

- participants littering the course with bottles or cups outside the aid station area
- not showing the bib during the race (The bib supplied by the organisers should be worn over any top or jacket and constantly visible throughout the race)
- not following the marked course or not to pass at time checks
- disallowing to the Antidoping Tests

In case of complaints, these should be provided to the Race Office within one hour from the official results publication. A deposit of Euro 50,00 is required and it will be refunded only in the case of complaint acceptance.
